History graduates have strong analytical and communication skills which can be put to good use in a range of careers including business, finance, journalism, politics, HR and law. They tend to be naturally suited to careers as museum or art gallery curators, or in academia or education.

#### Specific skills:

- good oral and written communication;
- ability to put together a logical argument;
- critical thinking;
- objectivity regarding 'right' and 'wrong';
- gathering, investigating and assessing material;
- condensing or expanding facts, ideas and arguments;
- using different types of sources to cross-reference;
- basing conclusions on statistical research;
- organising material in a logical and coherent way;
- presenting information literally, orally and visually;
- an interest in culture;
- an ability to spot a train of events.
