Section A: Reading

one literature fiction text

Reading (40 marks) (25%)- one single text

- 1 short form question (1 x 4 marks)

Section B: Writing

descriptive or narrative writing

Writing (40 marks) (25%)

• 1 extended writing question (24 marks for content, 16 marks for technical accuracy)

Paper 2: Writer's viewpoints and Perspectives

Section A: Reading

one non-fiction text and one literary non-fiction text

Reading (40 marks) (25%) – two linked texts

- 1 short form question (1 x 4 marks)
- 2 longer form questions (1 x 8, 1 x 12 marks)
- 1 extended question (1 x 16 marks)

Section B: Writing

writing to present a viewpoint

1 extended writing question (24 marks for content, 16 marks for technical accuracy)
