We believe these trips are important for all students to attend, to gather as much information as possible to help make the best-informed decisions on your progression routes, also there is information that will still be useful to all students even if university is not your current chosen pathway. Therefore, it is expected that all students will be attending these trips, unless there is a reason for your absence that would be the same reason as to why you would have been absent to Sixth Form that day. If this is the case, please do email Ms Watson with the reason you cannot attend (if you have not done so already). If there are any issues with being able to make the payment, please do speak with your tutor or myself.
