Year 7 Summer Term PDT Lesson Curriculum Overview

As a part of your child's education at Notley High School & Braintree Sixth Form, we promote personal wellbeing and development through a comprehensive Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education programme delivered in PDT lessons.

PSHE education is the curriculum subject that gives young people the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills to live safe, healthy, productive lives and meet their full potential.

I am writing to let you know the curriculum overview for PDT lessons in Year 7 during Summer term 2 is as follows:

Summer Term 2

Citizenship: Students will explore the meaning of 'refugee' and will investigate the reasons why people migrate. They will look at the support that exists for refugees. Students will then learn about Human Rights, in particular the rights that all children share, and the rights children have if their parents separate. They will consider what they can do to protect their rights.

PSHE education is taught throughout the school in every year group and is monitored and reviewed regularly by the staff and governing body.
