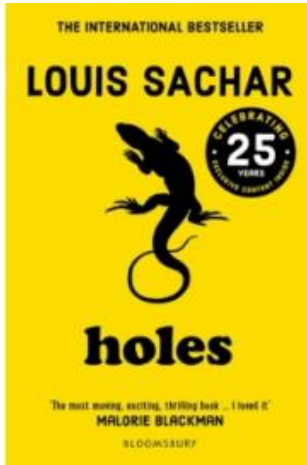
### *Notley High School curriculum books*

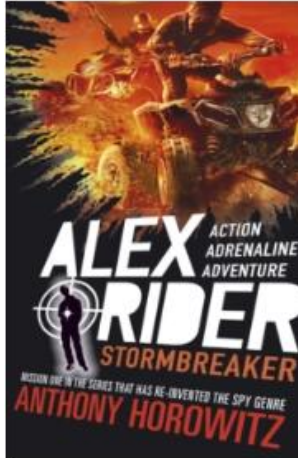
### **Private Peaceful by Michael Morpurgo**

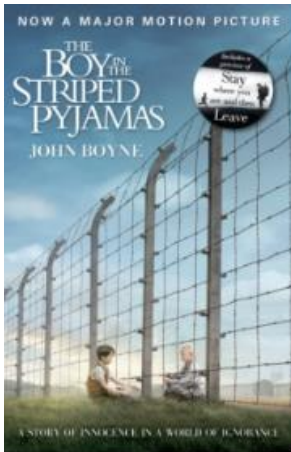
### **Skellig by David Almond**

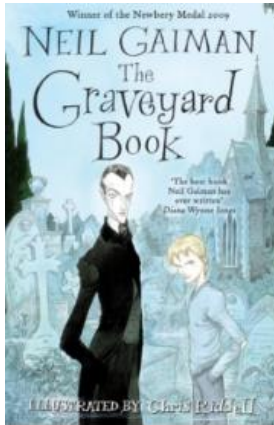
### **The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas by John Boyne**

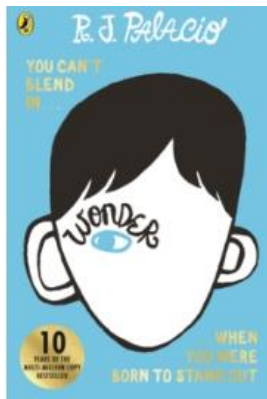
### **The Graveyard Book by Neil Gaiman**

Augie has a terrible facial abnormality. He wants everyone to treat him normally but how can they when he looks so different. How can he persuade everyone that he's just like them?

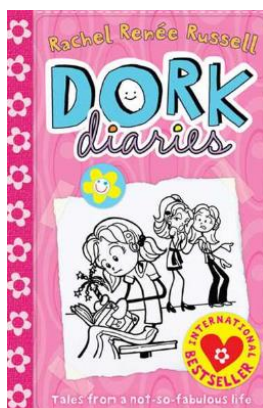
## ***NHS Library Recommendations***

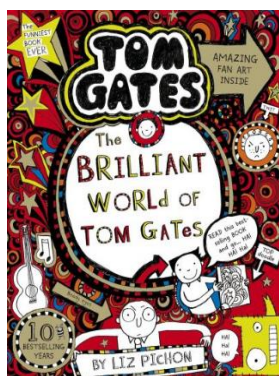

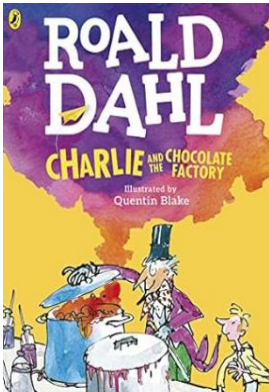

Written in diary form, the Tom Gates books are full of pictures and doodles and his brilliant sense of humour. This series is perfect for boys and girls mainly because it is so funny!

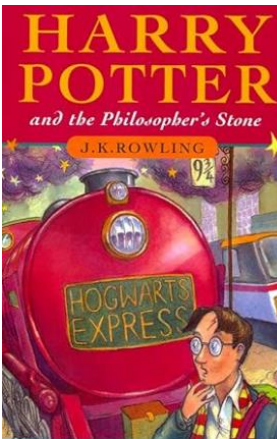

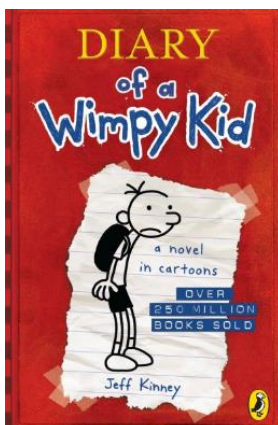

A group of friends set up a babysitting club where parents can call one number and reach several babysitters. Follow their adventures, friendships, school and family issues through this book series.

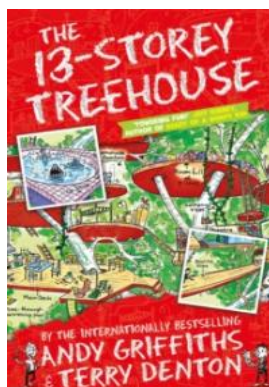

Part of a series this book is full of illustrations and will make you laugh out loud. Good for fans of Dog Man, this best selling book is full of wacky, tree-house adventures.

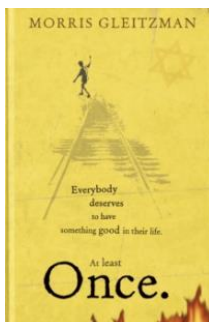

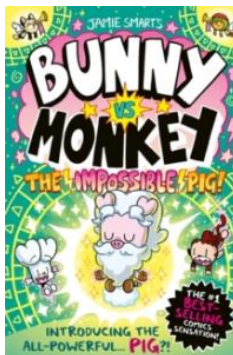
