X-FACTOR sensation Olly Murs is believed to be dating a fellow contestant he met at boot camp.

Olly, of Carraways, Witham, has been pictured in a national newspaper cuddling up with Project A singer Laura Henderson.

Olly is a former Notley High School pupil.

The pair were snapped on a bench in a north west London park near the wannabe pop-stars' digs last Tuesday.

They were pictured laughing, kissing and gazing into each others' eyes.

Laura, 21, was wearing a red jumper, black trousers tucked into her knee-high boots and had her legs resting over the 25-year-old's lap.

Olly, who wore blue trousers, a blue patterned jumper and red checked shirt, was looking smitten as he had his arm
